In 2023 we are planning to organize in The Centre for Education and Dialog Theotokos (Erasmus no. E10259074) various bibliodramatical activities. If you are interested in cooperation under the Erasmus + programme or without it you are welcome to:

1. Job shadowing

Bibliodrama Summer School – six days of bibliodrama workshops for people who do not have or have small previous bibliodrama experience and are also interested in theoretical aspects of bibliodrama.

Ignatian retreats with bibliodrama. 8-days spiritual exercises given with use of bibliodrama. **Both activities will be in Polish.**

2. Participation in

School for bibliodrama animators. 2-years training course for bibliodrama facilitators, **provided in Polish language.**

3-days (weekend) bibliodrama workshops leaded by invited bibliodrama facilitators from abroad, in English or other European languages.

3. The possibility to organize a bibliodrama event in The Centre for Education and Dialog Theotokos.

We can offer accommodation and board for 20 people, as well as the room for bibliodrama workshops. We can also offer the Centre as a partner for Erasmus requirements but the organization of event(s) and gathering the group is on your side.
